SIGNATURE EVENTS - LEVELS RANGING \$500 - \$25,000

Maple Sugaring Festival – February/March

Over 300 attendees, mostly families and scout troops learn about the maple sugar process and its connection to the land and native peoples.

Wissahickon Creek Clean Up – Last Saturday in April

Over 400 families, community groups, and businesses from across the region clean the Wissahickon Creek and celebrate their hard work at the Talkin' Trash" picnic.

Tex Mex 5k Race for Open Space - Wednesday in June

Hosted by Tex Mex Connection restaurant, this race is a 33 year tradition that attracts 1500 runners, 120 volunteers, and the North Wales community. Wissahickon Trails has been the main beneficiary for 24 years.

Walk the Wissahickon - late September

A yearly tradition since 1996, bringing 150 walkers onto the Green Ribbon Trail with guided walks at various lengths with stops for snacks and lunch along the way.

Craft Beer by the Creek

This family (and dog) friendly event features live music, local craft beer/cider and food trucks at the Four Mills Barn, Wissahickon Trail's headquarters.

Green Ribbon Gala - Wednesday in October

Largest fundraising event of the year celebrating the Wissahickon Trails' community with 200-250 attendees.

Green Ribbon Trail Race - 1st Saturday in November

150 runners enjoy a 5-mile fall trail run on the Green Ribbon Trail followed by brunch.

CONSERVATION PROJECTS - COST VARIES BY PROJECT

With 1,300 acres, 12 preserves, and 24 miles of trails to protect and maintain, conservation projects are always ready and available for funding and volunteers. Companies can provide support to a range of projects including trail maintenance, tree planting, and habitat restoration.

Service Projects

Your company can support Wissahickon Trails by planning a corporate service day. Service projects are seasonal and can vary in size and scope but usually include outdoor work supporting our land or community science initiatives. We will work with you to accommodate your team's interests, size, and schedule. **Donations are required and vary based on the project. Corporate sponsors receive priority for service days.**

- Trail maintenance including building or repair of boardwalks and bridges
- Planting and maintenance of new trees and shrubs
- Invasive plant removal
- Pollinator projects such as Caterpillars Count and Monarch tagging
- Creek clean ups





ENGAGEMENT PROGRAMS - LEVELS RANGING \$500 - \$5,000

We engage community members of all ages in a variety of educational initiatives. Sponsorship of these programs range from \$500 - \$5,000 and include recognition of your company's support through all our marketing channels and at in-person programs. Appropriate sponsorship level will be discussed per project based on the needs of the sponsor and Wissahickon Trails.

Community Science Program

Community Scientists collect data about the wildlife and habitats throughout our preserves through programs such as Monarch tagging, Nest Box monitoring, and Creek Watch. This data is used to determine future management plans and provides community members a way to make a significant contribution in a hands on way.



Nature Programs & Hikes

Over 1000 community members participate in in person & virtual programs each year with Wissahickon Trails. Nature programs provide opportunities to learn about native gardening, bird migration, creek life, moths, and much more. Guided hikes are offered throughout the seasons and showcase a variety of preserves and trail connections in the Wissahickon Valley.
